Students at Mow Poe Klo, Mow Kwee and Maeslid Kee MU Nursery Schools have learned alphabets, colours, animals, parts of the body, counting and numbers, foods and fruits, shapes, and health and cleanliness through stories, action songs and games.

The three Principals and six teachers have worked hard, encouraging children at the Schools. They have attended teacher training sessions and refresher courses to give them more knowledge of teaching and creative skills.

While the children have been hard at work learning, parents have been able to tend their farms, weave and search out seasonal vegetables from the forest.

Now the children have been prepared, they will attend primary school in the coming year.
